HOUSE BILL NO. 123

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 1 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO SPECIAL DAYS AND SPECIAL MONTHS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend Title 1 of the Delaware Code by adding a new section to read as follows:

2 "§ 609. Disability History and Awareness Month.

3 The following month shall be commemorated in this State by appropriate ceremonies: the month of October,
4 known as Disability History and Awareness Month. In commemorating such month, public schools are encouraged to
5 informally offer instruction and events highlighting disability history and awareness during October of each year which
6 may include offering guest speakers, supplementing existing lesson plans, holding assemblies, and sponsoring essay or art
7 projects.

SYNOPSIS

This bill designates the month of October as "Disability History and Awareness Month." Without limitation, this amendment encourages public schools to participate in the commemoration of Disability History and Awareness Month through certain school activities.
