

**NEW opportunity this year! *The Cape Henlopen Writing Retreat Fellowship.***

This Fellowship awards a four-day writing retreat at The Virden Conference Center, including room and board, with no payment of fee required. The fellowship is intended to provide a selected Delaware writer with an opportunity for intensive and undivided attention to work over a four-day period. In 2014, one poet or prose writer will be chosen for this fellowship award. The fellowship will run concurrently with the biennial Cape Henlopen Writing Retreat and its workshops.

The Cape Henlopen Writing Retreat Fellow is not required to attend a poetry or prose workshop. This is a non-directed retreat, offered as unrestricted use of time to generate or revise work. However, the fellow is expected to offer a one-hour craft session or lecture on a topic of choice on Saturday morning, open to all participants. Who may apply: *Delaware residents may apply.*
